

2010 Native American High School Summer program at Harvard Medical School is now looking for a chaperone and 4 students to attend the 2010 Program. The program will start on **Saturday, June 26th** and end on **Friday July 16th**.

Students will be able to attend the powwow and we are working on the other tribes that will be in attendance at the program. (Aquinnah, Assiniboine Sioux, Hopi, and Hawaii).

The chaperone must be at **least 25 years of age** with experience in chaperoning/supervising students. The students must be rising sophomores, juniors, and seniors that are interested in medical field careers (*nurse, doctor, psychologist, pharmacist, medical research, etc..) and willing to stay at Harvard in the dorms with other tribal youth participants for **three weeks**. This program focuses on Substance Abuse and its effects on the brain, body, families and communities.

This is a wonderful experience for our high School Students as we have sent **22 students** thus far. 2010 application packets for both student and chaperone are available. The application will need to be accompanied with a bio/essay on why you would like to attend/ chaperone the program.
