All enrolled Tribal Youth Ages 5-18 are eligible to submit a lottery application to win \$250.00 to provide assistance with any sports affiliated program costs. 30 Lottery Winners will be awarded during a drawing at the Sunday General Meeting on September 11th 2011.

Frequently Asked Questions

How much money is going to be awarded to each winner?

The award is for \$250.00 per winner per year. The award is paid on behalf of the child to the program the youth is interested in attending. If there is leftover dollars from the award that are not needed by the youth – that money will go into a new lottery at the end of the coming year.

Will I have to give you documentation from the sport program that I am approved to attend and the full cost (whether or not I only pay a portion)?

Yes, documentation of the program and its costs will be required upon Award. The Award can cover up to \$250.00 per year of costs – but not more.

What are the conditions to apply for this help (school grades, behavior activities)?

The conditions to apply to the Lottery are that the youth is an enrolled tribal member. Passing school grades and appropriate behavior are required to keep the Award.

How many times can I apply (every year or one time only for fairness to others)?

The Lottery will be held on September 11th at the Mashpee High School General Body meeting. Awards will be made then to 30 winners. If for any reason Awards are returned or not used in full over the course of the coming year – then those remaining funds will be used to hold a 2nd Lottery during the following year. All Tribal Youth are eligible to apply until they win an award.

What happens if my child doesn't complete the program (quits, gets kicked out, etc.) Am I responsible to pay back the Tribe?

No, because the Award is not made directly to the parent, family or child – but instead is paid to the sports program – if a child does not complete the program the parent is not responsible to repay the Award.

What will happen to any left over funding? (say we give \$250.00 per child and their program only cost \$100.00 then there is \$150.00 left – can that be used for another child)?

If there is leftover dollars from the award that are not needed by the youth – that money will go into a new lottery to be held in September 2012.

Will payment go directly to the company?
